Fort Myers oldest public art work may have found a home at the Fort Myers - Lee Council Botanical Garden. Our dear Corresponding Secretary - Kay Holloway wears many hats. The sculpture arrived by boat from Italy in 1930 and was placed in Rea's garden on the Caloosahatchee - not far from the Council's current location. In 1955, Rea bequeathed the "comely German siren" to the Fort Myers Public Library. She has been on display there since 1961 but will not make the move downtown as the new Library opens.
