Each Sunday, we promote native plants by bringing a large selection from the on-site nursery to the historic site. We offer advice help with plant selections. Through September, the \$1 environmental impact fee to enter the park for the Koreshan Farmers Market and Native Plant Sale is waived. Stop by 3800 Corkscrew Road, Estero, FL 33928. The park is leashed -dog friendly. We'd love to see you. On Thursday, September 15 at 7 pm, our favorite Lee County Mosquito Control mosquito biologist Kara Tyler-Julian will be at Holton Eco-Preserve at Unitarian Universalist Church, 13411 Shire Lane, Fort Myers, FL 33912, to help us with BUGS! In her talk, Bugs ... the Good, the Bad and the Uglies, she will use her visual and interactive session to help us better identify the insects in our gardens. On Thursday, October 20 at 7 pm, Dr. Ed Hanlon, UF Professor Emeritus in Soil and Water will present DIRTy Science.
